SPECIAL REGULATIONS

DELIVERY: Exhibits to be delivered to the Stewards, Rotary Hall, Darwin Showgrounds, Shean Rd, Winnellie. Between 8:00am and 6:00pm on Monday 20th July and must remain for the duration of the Show.

COLLECTION: Exhibits to be collected between 8:00am and 12noon on Sunday 26th July

IDENTIFICATION: Exhibit cards must be produced for the collection of prizemoney voucher/s and exhibits.

INSURANCE: All exhibits will be covered by insurance only for theft by breaking and entry from the time of delivery to the Showgrounds until the time of removal and no longer than one week following the Show.
For this purpose entrants are required to state the full value of each exhibit on their entry form.

AMATEUR: AMATEUR ARTISTS, who by definition, do not derive more than 25% of their annual income from the production of their art work, such income to include prize monies and the value of art awards and scholarships received during the twelve months prior to entering.

EXHIBIT: Entries shall be the original work of artists submitting. No exhibit completed before the preceding twelve months will be accepted. Size of painting to be stated on entry form, exhibits must not exceed 130cm x 95cm excluding frame. **Exhibitor's name, address, class number and date painted must be clearly printed on reverse side of each exhibit.** No exhibit can be entered in more than one class.

ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED & READY FOR HANGING OR MAY NOT BE JUDGED.

Note: Perspex distorts, all exhibits must be titled. Stretched canvas frames will be accepted.

SALE: Price to be noted on reverse of painting. N.F.S. if not for sale. The Society will encourage the sale of exhibits and charges a 15% Commission for such sales. "For Sale" signs may be displayed after judging.

SCULPTURE: Definition- to occupy space no larger than 1m x 1m approx. A 3D structure or an interlocking interrelated series of a common material to be viewed from all sides without the need of additional "presentation".

INDIGENOUS ART: Entries in Indigenous art sections are subject to Aboriginal laws in regard to use and display of traditional designs. General Regulations No. 1-39 also apply.
