Class 1 DECORATIVE GARDEN DISPLAY or TROPICAL GARDEN DISPLAY - 1st: \$50 2nd: \$25

1. Maximum Size 3m wide x 3m deep.
2. To consist of any variety of flowers, shrubs, potted plants, palms etc.
3. Decorative pieces may be used to enhance the display.
4. All plants in display to be clearly labelled.
5. Display will be judged on overall effect, quality and variety.
Overall effect: 50 points Quality: 30 points Variety: 20 points

Class 2 INDUSTRY DISPLAY or FARM EXHIBIT - 1st: \$50 2nd: \$25

1. Minimum size 3m wide x 3m deep AND Maximum size 4m wide x 4m deep.
2. To consist of a variety of flowers, shrubs, potted plants, palms, fruit, horticulture/Agriculture products relevant to the industry etc.
3. Or Can have farm produce which is agricultural, market garden produce, farm cooking and preserves.
4. Decorative pieces may be included to enhance the display.
5. The exhibit may be entered by clubs, groups or progress associations, producer groups, other organized bodies and single individuals.
6. All items in display to be clearly labelled.i.e. plants, produce, preserves etc.
7. Display to be judged on overall effect, quality and variety.
Overall effect: 25 points Quality: 25 points Variety: 25 points Balance: 25 points
