### SPECIAL REGULATIONS

**PAVILION HOURS:** Joe Yates Pavilion will **OPEN at 9:00am** and **CLOSE at 9:00pm** - Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

**DELIVERY:** All Poultry must be delivered to Stewards, Joe Yates Pavilion, Darwin Showgrounds, Tate Place.  
Between 8:00am and 7:00pm on Wednesday 23rd July and must remain for the duration of the Show.

**COLLECTION:** All Poultry must be removed between 8:00am and 12:00noon on Sunday 27th July.

**STOCK:** Exhibitors should ensure that any requirements for stock movement are complied with. For information contact Stock Inspector's Office, Berrimah Farm during normal business hours. Stock Inspector on 8999 2031 or 0401112 031 or Regional Stock Inspector on 8999 2030.

**PENS:** Exhibitors are requested to advise the Society by phone or letter at least 2 weeks prior to penning date, if any exhibits cannot be penned. This will assist in avoiding empty pens within classes.

**ENTRIES:** PLEASE STATE VARIETY AND COLOUR ON ENTRY FORM. It is anticipated that all entries received will be accepted. However, the Council reserves the right to reduce the number of entries which may be accepted in any class or classes should there be insufficient penning space to accommodate all entries.

**HEALTH:** Leg bands may be worn but must not identify the owner or breeder.  
Exhibitors are requested to ensure their exhibits are in good health and condition when delivered to the Poultry Pavilion. Exhibits showing signs of sickness, disease, vermin or poor condition may be refused acceptance. Exhibitors are requested to ensure that exhibits are clean by examining their birds for lice and vermin prior to delivery. Properly prepared, clean exhibits in good show condition bring credit to the exhibitors and the show. Please help to maintain a high standard.

**CLASSES:** No exhibit may be entered in more than one class. Should an exhibit be incorrectly entered in more than one class, such exhibit shall be deemed ineligible to compete in any class other than the first one in which its name or particulars appear in this Schedule.

Birds entered in Breeding Classes are not eligible for individual awards of any nature.  
A new class may be made for three or more of any breed or variety with a minimum two exhibitors in that class or at Councillor and Chief Stewards discretion. All Old English Game cocks must be dubbed. In any other variety classes (AOV) please state variety & colour on entry form. In any class when there is more than one colour in the breed the colour should be advised on the entry form.

**HANDLING:** Birds are not to be handled after 8:00am on day of judging.

**FOOD:** Food containers to be removed where necessary by Steward prior to judging. Standard food only in pens prior and during judging. Selected feed can be replaced after judging.

**EGGS:** Eggs laid during show will be disposed of unless special arrangements are made with the chief steward.
