All exhibits, including containers, shall be in neat, clean condition, prepared for show bench competitive display on floor, shelves or tables, etc, provided. Sizes stated as: Height x Width (Base)
Each exhibit may be entered in one class only.
Judges reserve the right to reject non-established plants.

EXHIBITOR'S NAME & ADDRESS MUST NOT APPEAR ON FRONT OF EXHIBIT.

ENTRY FORMS: Entry forms must show exhibitor's full date of birth or exhibit will be judged in under 18 class. General Regulations 1-38 also apply.
