**DELIVERY:** Preserves and Beverages (Classes 35 - 66) to be delivered to the Stewards, Rotary Hall, Darwin Showgrounds, Shean Rd between 8:00am and 6:00pm on Monday 21st July.

All other Exhibits to be delivered between 8:00am and 12:00 noon on Wednesday 23rd July.

**COLLECTION:** Exhibits must be collected between 8:00am and 12:00 noon on Sunday 27th July.

**DISPOSAL:** Exhibits not collected within one week following the show may be disposed of at the Society's discretion.

**IDENTIFICATION:** Exhibit cards must be produced for the collection of prizemoney voucher/s and exhibits.

**EXHIBITS:** All preserves must be in plain glass jars with cleaned plain metal screw top lids, sizes 375g to 500g and no wax or plastic seals (except vacuum packed fruit and vegetables).

Packet mixtures MUST NOT be used for cakes or pastry. No icing or icing sugar, unless specified. Specified recipes & container sizes must be used where specified or competitor may be disqualified. Unless specified, all cakes to be made in 20cm round tin. Exhibits not complying to above rules will not be judged.

All cake and biscuit entries to be on firm round, non decorative, disposable white plates of suitable size for entry. White paper doileys permitted. **Enclose in Oven Bag.** Cling Wrap is NOT permitted. No exhibit may be entered in more than one class. General regulations Nos. 1 - 38 also apply.

### SET CAKE RECIPES

(Metric cup and spoon measurements)

**BUTTER CAKE:** 250gr butter, 250gr castor sugar, 4 eggs, 2 1/2 cups self raising flour, 1/2 cup milk, 1/2 tspn vanilla essence. 20cm round tin.

**JUBILEE CAKE:** 1 1/2 cups s.r. flour, 2 tblsp sugar, 1 tblsp butter or margarine, 1 egg, 3/4 cup mixed fruit, 1/2 cup milk. Rub in butter method. Loaf tin approx 9cm x 22cm. Iced, icing sugar and milk.

**DARK FRUIT CAKE:** 90gr chopped red glace cherries, 90gr chopped blanched almonds, 250gr currants, 250gr chopped raisins, 175gr chopped sultanas, 125gr chopped mixed peel, 250gr butter, 250gr soft brown sugar, 250gr plain flour, 60gr s.r. flour, 1 tsp ground nutmeg, 1/2 tsp ground spice, 1/4 tsp ground cloves, 1/2 tsp lemon essence or grated rind, 1/3 cup sherry or brandy, 4 eggs. 22 - 23cm round tin.

**SULTANA CAKE:** 2 cups plain flour, 1 1/2 tspns baking powder, 1 1/4 cups butter, 1 cup castor sugar, 1/4 cup mixed peel, 1 cup sultanas, 4 large eggs, 1/4 cup milk. 20cm round tin.

**BOILED FRUIT CAKE:** 1/2 cup butter, 1 cup sugar, 1 cup currants, 1 cup sultanas, 1 cup raisins, 1 tspn mixed spice, 1/4 cup mixed peel, 1/2 cup water, 1/2 cup brandy, 1 cup s.r. flour, 1 cup plain flour, 2 eggs, 1 tspn bicarb soda. 20 cm round tin.


